Developing African Leaders

We develop African leaders through education, HIV/AIDS care and prevention, economic empowerment, and spiritual development. For over 25 years, we have been strengthening individuals, families, and communities throughout the northwest region of Botswana.

EDUCATION

We develop students' full potential through faith-based education in our international school and supplemental learning programs.

Okavango International School is a world-class educational institute, serving Kindergarten through Grade 12 with the highest standard of academics and extracurricular programs. We strive to develop our students into well-educated men and women of character and service.

We also sponsor informal educational programs which help adults achieve their graduation equivalency certificates. This provides a vital second chance for those formerly held back due to a lack of education.

HIV CARE & PREVENTION

We provide HIV care and prevention through youth abstinence clubs and a rescue center for abandoned babies and vulnerable children.

With the second highest infection rate in the world, every single person in Botswana has been affected by HIV/AIDS in some way. The most lasting way to spearhead radical change is through a commitment to faith-based living. We lead after-school abstinence clubs, teaching young people to make wise choices in every area of their lives.

Lorato House of Love is an emergency rescue center and orphanage for abandoned babies and children in need of care. We provide a safe and nurturing atmosphere for the children while they await reunification with their extended family or adoption into a new, loving family. Our facility is the first of its kind in the nation, providing physical, mental, emotional, and spiritual refuge for the most vulnerable of our society.

ECONOMIC EMPOWERMENT

We empower families and communities in poverty to develop self-sustainability through skills training and micro-enterprise development.

Our Maatla outreach provides artisan and agricultural skill training to primary caregivers of orphaned and vulnerable children. Men and women are trained and equipped to work out of their own homes, developing small businesses that provide long-term sustainability for their families.

As individuals and their families are strengthened and fortified, so are the communities in which they live. These development programs are transforming lives and villages, and breaking the cycle of poverty.
